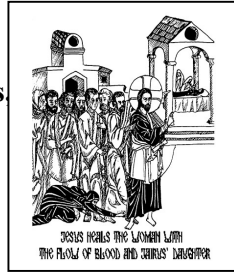

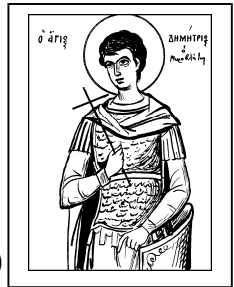

ARCHEPARCHY ASSEMBLY NEWS – At the Assembly there were three areas of concerns and hope for the future of our Church that were discussed. St. John the Baptist sent two representatives, Deborah Klink and Mark Jesko, to evaluate these areas of concern and present them to the parish for implementation. The first area deals with Education. It was decided that on-going adult education be offered with courses at both our parish and at St. Stephen in Leisenring. Second, the Social Ministry promote a sense of parish community and develop physical presence in our larger community. It was decided to do tours of our church, set up greeters for Liturgies, and additional social activities. Third, Outreach to encourage new and renewed interest in our church. Facebook will be used to promote our parish and parish activities, promote our Liturgies on YouTube, and obtain and use parishioner email.
