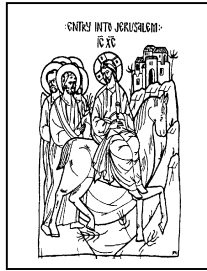

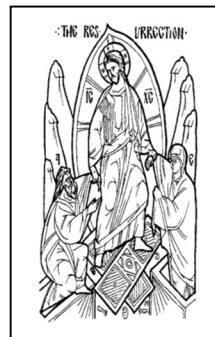

FROM THE METROPOLITAN ARCHBISHOP OF PITTSBURGH
Most Reverend William C. Skurla:

“...Effective immediately, all public Liturgical celebrations are being suspended until further notice. This includes Sunday Divine Liturgy, Lenten Services and Holy Days. The faithful of the Archeparchy are dispensed from the obligation of attending Sunday and Holy Day Divine Liturgies, but you should keep holy the Lord’s Day through prayer and support of those in need in your Church.”

All other activities are cancelled, except baptisms, weddings, and funerals. Parishioners are encouraged to “attend” any live streaming or radio broadcasts of Byzantine Divine Services. These are listed below.

BLESSING OF EASTER FOODS – While the Church is closed for Holy Saturday and Easter Sunday Divine Liturgy, Easter Foods will be blessed after the Divine Liturgy at the following times: on Holy Saturday at 7:00 p.m. and on Easter Sunday at 10:15 a.m. in the parking lot. Place your Easter baskets on the hood of your car and Father Ron will bless them.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION – During the Covid-19 situation, Father Ron asks if you want to go to the Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession) to please call him at 724-438-6027 to arrange a time. He will hear your confession in your automobile.

DIVINE LITURGIES ON YOUTUBE - St. John the Baptist Byzantine, Uniontown, will video and then post on YouTube the Divine Liturgies for both Palm Sunday and the Resurrection.
