<u>SPIRITUAL PREPARATION FOR CHRISTMAS</u> – We begin our second full week in our journey through the PHILLIPIAN FAST. The Byzantine Catholic Church does not use the Latin language (Advent in the Roman rite) to describe this penitential season, since its traditional language is based on Greek. This minor penitential period directs us to prepare ourselves for the spiritual meaning of Christmas. May we allow Him to be reborn in our souls by sanctifying the temple of our Body. Through prayer, abstinence, almsgivings of mercy, frequent confession of sins, and additional attendances at the Divine Liturgies we can accomplish this end. Together as a parish, let us collectively begin our practice of *Simple Abstinence (no meat)* or an *equivalent penance (your choice)* on Wednesdays (recommended) and Fridays (required) for the intention of the return of our beloved back to Church.
