

Please reach out to your state representative and ask them to support a package of <u>pro-life bills</u> that will be considered by the PA House Health Committee next week and then—hopefully—for us all to protect. will move on to the full House for consideration. Here are the three bills and what they call for:

- *HB 118, the Final Disposition of Fetal Remains Act,* which would give parents the option of burial or cremation after the death of their unborn baby
- *HB 1500, the Down Syndrome Protection Act,* which would protect a child from being killed if he or she has been diagnosed with Down syndrome.
- *HB 904, the Fetal Heartbeat Bill,* which would prohibit an abortion once a heartbeat is detected in the unborn baby.
