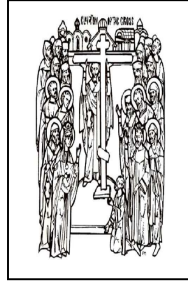

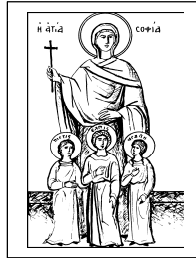

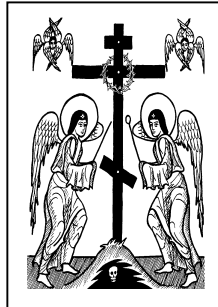

Catechetical Sunday 2021

It's hard to believe, but next Sunday is Catechetical Sunday. Parents should be sure to have their children ready for the blessing. And, if you are already beyond the phase in life that you have children in school, be sure to be present to pray for the next generation of holy people.

Next Sunday, an important event will take place in our parish. The ceremony will emphasize the importance of religious instruction: a responsibility not only of catechists, but parents as well. During the Divine Liturgy we will pray for our catechists and students as they begin the new catechetical school year. Students and teachers will be blessed asking God's guidance in their studies during both the Saturday evening, 5:30 p.m. and Sunday morning, 9:00 a.m. Divine Liturgies, the 18th and 19th of September.

The priest will bless them in their good work. Let us ask the Lord our God to grant them wisdom, knowledge, understanding and holiness! *We ask that all catechists and students be present.*
