Please join us for a special opening of the exhibit for our parish family on Sunday, October 23 beginning at 1:00PM. East Meets West pays tribute to eight innovative artists, students of a new school of iconography in the cultural center of Lviv, Ukraine, who blend traditional Byzantine iconography, modernist painting techniques and elements of Eastern European folk art to visualize Christian narratives as both ancient and accessible. These artists have pioneered a style of sacred art native to Ukrainian Greek Catholicism at a time when their nation defends itself from Russian invasion. Throughout the duration of the exhibition, a free-will offering will be collected to benefit Ridni Charitable Fund, an organization in Lviv that supports children who have been orphaned or displaced as a result of the war. 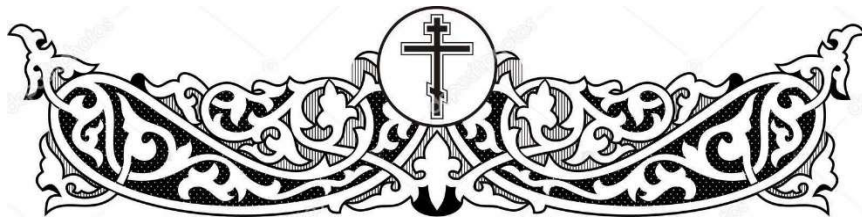
