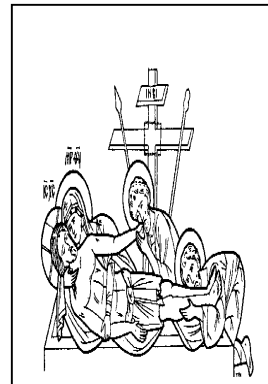
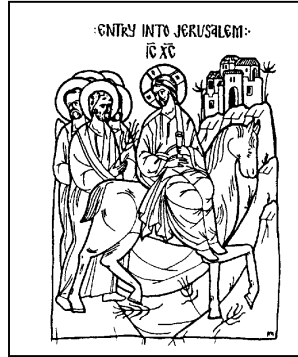

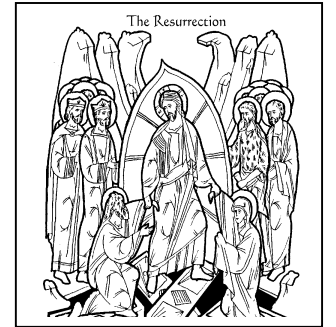

PLEASE SIGN UP FOR AN HOUR - After the death and burial of Our Lord, soldiers were ordered to guard the grave. They did because it was their duty (Mt. 27:65,66). We are not ordered, but like the apostles, we are invited by Christ to “WATCH and PRAY with me for one hour” (Mt. 26:38,40). There is a sign up sheet in the narthex.

POSTURE DURING PASCHAL SEASON – The Paschal Season lasts from the Feast of the Resurrection until the Feast of Pentecost. During Pre-Lent and Lent, kneeling and prostrations are most appropriate gestures to honor our Lord and to remind us of our obedience, submission, and reverence for Him. During Paschal Season we stand because Christ, being Almighty, is Risen, and He lifts us up just as He lifted our Ancient Parents, Adam and Eve. **WE STAND TO GREET THE RISEN CHRIST and WE ALWAYS STAND WHEN WE SING: CHRIST IS RISEN!** – the only exceptions are those resulting from age, illness or pregnancy.

FASTING OBLIGATIONS – **HOLY WEDNESDAY IS A DAY OF SIMPLE ABSTINENCE** – no meat or meat products. **GOOD FRIDAY IS A DAY OF STRICT FAST AND ABSTINENCE** – no meat milk, butter, eggs, dairy products, etc. **HOLY SATURDAY IS A DAY OF SIMPLE ABSTINENCE** – no meat or meat products.

EASTER SUNDAY OBLIGATION – Parishioners must attend for their obligation of worship Vespers with the Divine Liturgy of St. Basil on Saturday evening or a Sunday morning Divine Liturgy of St. John Chrysostom (Eucharistic Divine Liturgy).
