The First Ecumenical Council was held in Nicea in A.D. 325 and set a pattern for all later Ecumenical Councils. The council was summoned by the Emperor St. Constantine the Great, who desired unity in the Roman Empire and thus called the Church's bishops together. It primarily addressed the issue of Arianism, the doctrine that Jesus Christ was a created being and therefore not truly the

one God. It produced the original version of the Nicene Creed and set a universal pattern for calculating the date of Pascha the Paschalion.
