

Catechetical Sunday 2020

It's hard to believe, next Sunday is Catechetical Sunday. Parents should be sure to have their children ready for the blessing. And, if you are already beyond the phase in life that you have children in school, be sure to be present to pray for the next generation of holy people. Aunts, uncles, older brothers and sisters, along with grandparents are included in the term "family," and, as such, share in the imagery of God. God is Trinity—three persons, yet one God. Family is not confined to the number "three," but the principle is the same. Each individual shares a common bond with each other individual—that makes them "one." Students and teachers will be blessed asking God's guidance in their studies during both the Saturday evening, 5:30 p.m. and Sunday morning, 9:00 a.m. Divine Liturgies, the 19th and 20th of September.

The theme of Catechetical Sunday this year is "Christ the Heavenly Bread." The God With Us curriculum builds upon the faith initiated through Baptism, Chrismation and Holy Eucharist. In the curriculum you will find the following lessons on the Holy Eucharist as an additional resource for reflection: "I'm Thankful for Holy Communion," "We Receive Jesus," "We Receive Holy Communion," "Living in God's Love," "The Liturgy Enables Us to be the Church," "Pascha, the New Passover," "We Are Sharers in Jesus' Victory," and "Holy Eucharist Nourishes Us on Our Journey."

As we begin the new catechetical year 2020 let us take time to meditate on the reflections, grow in our love and gratitude for the gift of the Holy Eucharist, sharing that love with those entrusted to our care. May we all Faith-fully navigate through this pandemic, knowing and trusting that God is With Us.
