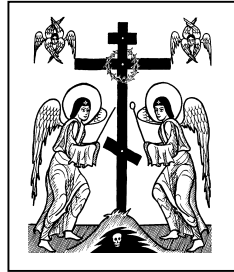

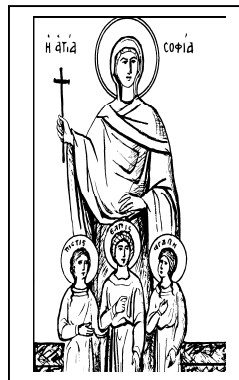

### **SUNDAY AFTER THE ELEVATION OF THE PRECIOUS CROSS**

**I HAVE BEEN CRUCIFIED WITH CHRIST; IT IS NO LONGER I WHO LIVE, BUT CHRIST LIVES IN ME**

Observe here too how cautiously he expresses himself; he does not say that they had abandoned the Law as evil, but as weak. If the law cannot confer righteousness, it follows that circumcision is superfluous; and so far he now proves, but he proceeds to show that it is not only superfluous but dangerous ... He speaks more strongly ... If faith in him, says he, does not avail for our justification, but it be necessary again to embrace the law, and if, having forsaken the law for Christ’s sake, we are not justified but condemned for such abandonment, then will we find Him, for whose sake we forsook the law and went over to faith ... Observe how he has resolved the matter to a necessary absurdity ... Observe the Apostle’s discernment; his opponents endeavored to show that he who did not keep the law was a transgressor, but he retorts the argument upon them, and shows that he
